TAKE NOTICE that the Township of Russell will hold a public meeting on November 26, 2025, at 6:00 p.m., in the Gaston Patenaude Hall located at 717 Notre-Dame Street in Embrun in order to consider a proposed Building Permit Fee By-law under **Section 7** of the *Building Code Act*.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT - The Township of Russell is proposing to adopt (amend) a Building Permit Fee By-law following a review of the building permit fees under **Section 7** of the *Building Code Act*. The effect will be to increase the existing fee structure and introduce new fees. Information will be provided at the meeting on the estimated costs of enforcing and administering the *Building Code Act*, the amount of the proposed fee(s) and the rationale for changing (and/or imposing) fees.

ANY PERSON may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed fees.
